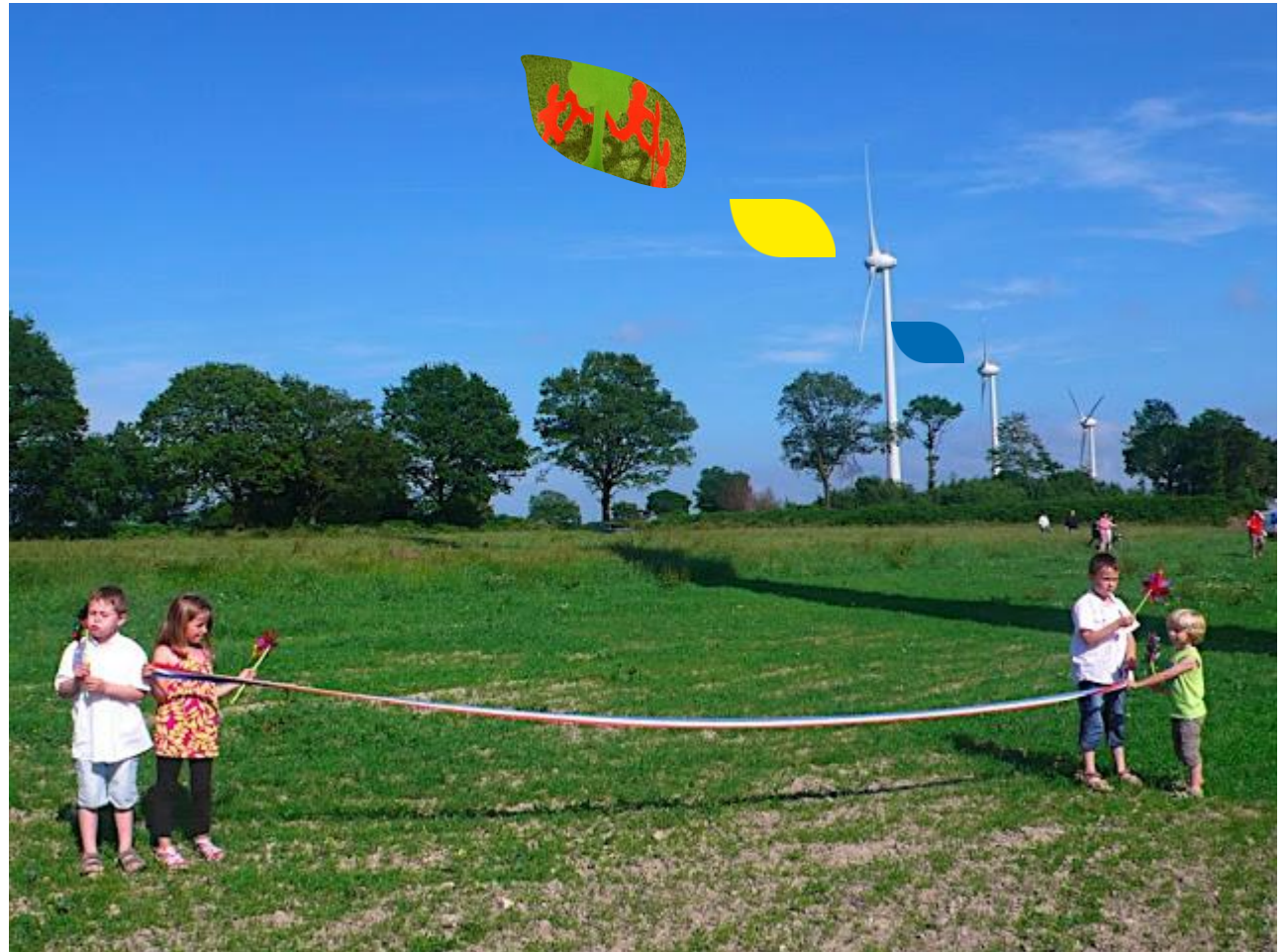

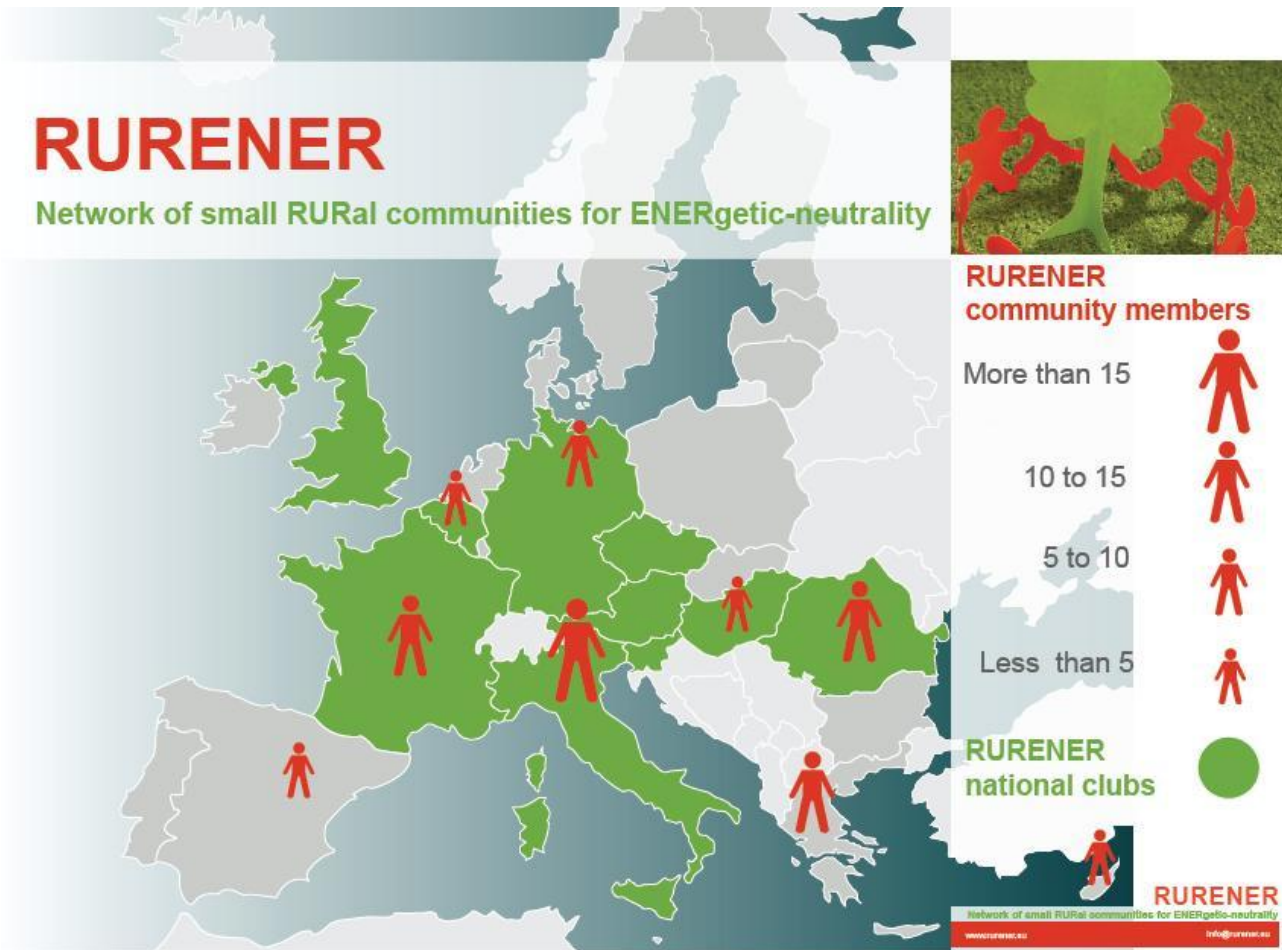

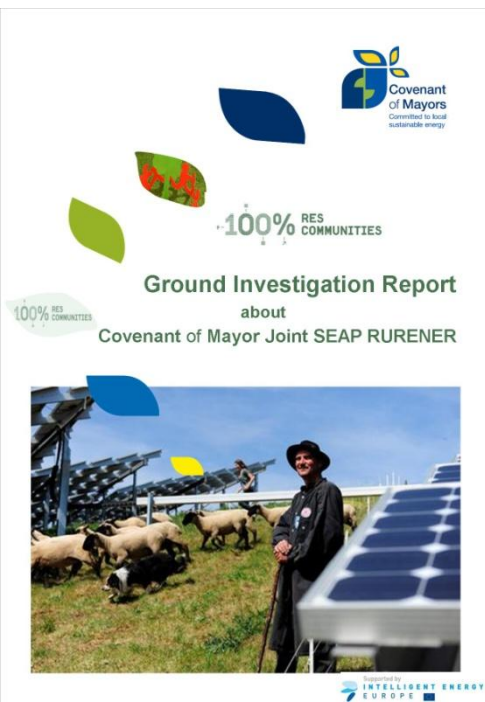

Lack of human resources

Technical issues

- “energy inefficient buildings”
- negotiation with big energy companies due to the technical complexities of the topics.

Financial issues

- less than 5000 euro for sustainable energy initiatives (this amount does not include the initiative and action of the CoM)
- one of the internal obstacles to the CoM is the large administrative cost relating to it.
- a strong bias towards the urban frame and are targeted to large municipalities with the exclusion of small communities.

Communication and policy process

- relationships between rural communities and the CoM; technical and bureaucratic language; not enough structured; few translated versions ; CoM website not very user-friendly;
- The set of actions, information, documents, actors which composes the policy of the CoM is not very clear

Rural municipalities are running a head with joint SEAP



- For neighbouring municipalities it is possible to adhere to the CoM as a group of municipalities
