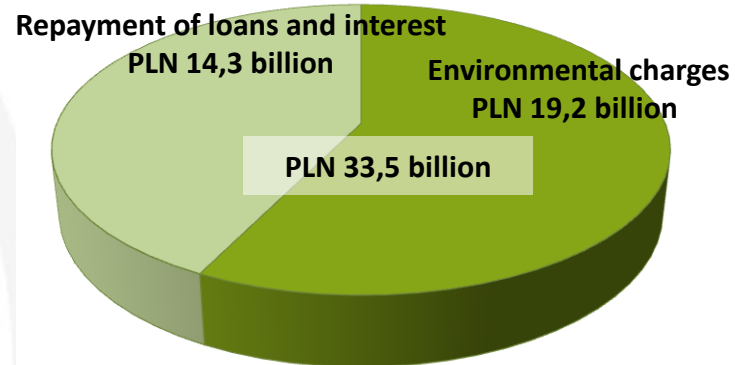
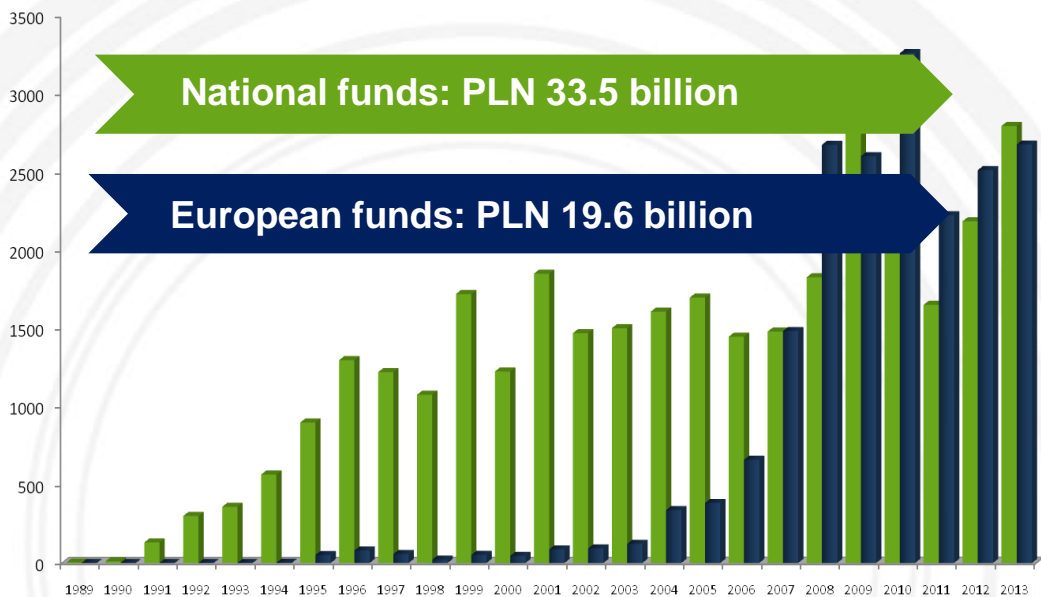


# The National Fund for Environmental Protection and Water Management

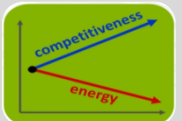

# Selected Priority Programmes (National Fund, GIS)

## Financing support for projects to 31 December 2020

- energy-efficient public utility buildings;
- low-energy houses;
- dispersed, renewable energy sources;
- Prosument - line of financing for the purchase and installation of renewable energy sources micro-installations;

## Financing support for projects to 31 December 2015

- energy-efficient street lighting;
- low-emission municipal transport;
- energy management in public buildings;





# Local low-emission energy plans

(IE OP - action 9.3)

**Objective:** Climate and EU 2020 energy package and the CAFE directive

## Types of projects supported:

- development or update of the low-emission plan as well SEAP;
- creation of a database – an inventory of GHG emissions;
- training on low carbon economy;
- promotion of low carbon economy;

**Budget of the programme – PLN 10 mln**

## Implementing Agency

- National Fund for Environmental Protection and Water Management;

## Beneficiaries:

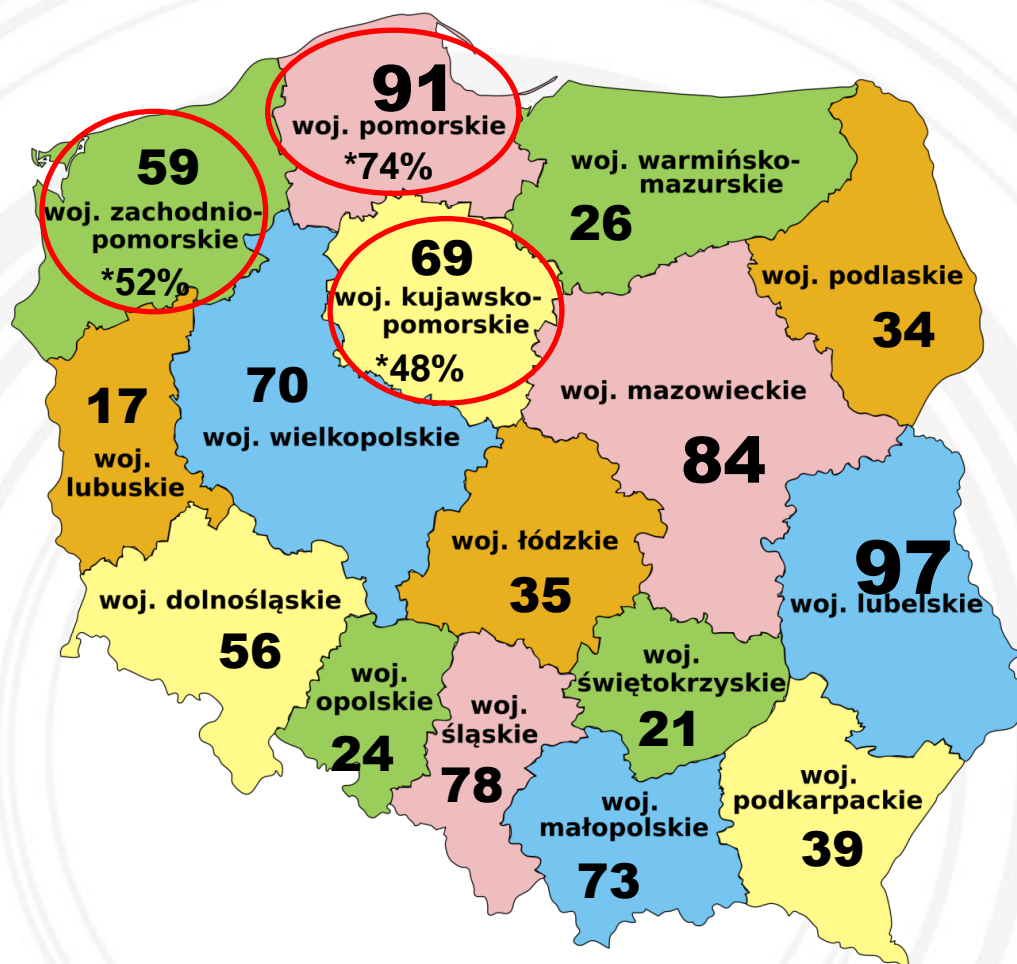
- municipalities, associations of municipalities including current CoM signatories;

## Form of support:

- subsidy for up to 85% of eligible costs;

# Plans for a low carbon economy

(IE OP – action 9.3)



- **764** – number of submitted applications (including 12 group applications);
- **873** – number of communes/ municipalities participating in the contest (35% of communes/ municipalities in Poland);
- Requested amount of co-financing **PLN 48,7 mln** (total amount **PLN 56,9 mln**);
- \* activity of communes and municipalities from a given voivodship



# Next steps

- Creating an advisory system for energy efficiency at the national and local level;
- Drawing up new call for proposal for low-emission energy plans;
- Monitoring of low-emission energy plans;
- Promotion of COM and SEAP methodology
